

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q. Do I need a passport?

A. Yes.

Q. Do I need vaccinations?

A. There are no required vaccines.

Q. Will I really be performing surgery on a live patient?

A. Yes. We are partnered with the School of Dental Sciences Advanced Education program for Jamaica. There is an abundance of patients for dental implant treatment.

Q. What about accommodations?

A. We have a designated travel agent who will assist course participants. We are getting excellent group rates. Course and accommodations have to be paid at least a month and a half in advance. Cancellations 30 days prior to the course will be assessed a 50% service charge for Jamaica seminar and 20% service charge for Clifton, NJ seminar.

Q. Can I bring my family?

A. Yes. We encourage you to bring your family. If you choose to stay longer, you will get a discounted rate at the hotel.

Q. How many dentists per class?

A. There are 7-9 dentists in New Jersey. 14-16 dentists are in Jamaica. Our goal is to spend time with each dentist, perfecting his/her ability so techniques can be implemented immediately. Also Individual instructor guidance and supervision will be available for each implant placement.

Q. Do I need any additional documents?

A. Yes. You need to complete the registration form. ADIS will get the necessary working permits. All documents must be submitted a month and a half before the course.

Q. Do I need a rental car?

A. Only if you wish. We will provide all transportation to and from the airport and training facility.
